8.0 CREDITS MINIMUM

***Math Foundations will be coded as a MA (math) for students on a modified diploma or IEP**

All classes are aligned with the state standards and the district standards.

CREDITS are awarded depending on/but not limited to:

1. Time spent
2. Material covered
3. Knowledge gained
4. Passing of a test at 80% or better

Teachers and staff may prepare participants for the following tests:

GED/ASVAB/OAKS/SAT/ACT/Accuplacer

TABE TEST – Test of Adult Basic Education

(Determines their ability and placement in English and Math)

All participants take the pre-TABE test in week 2

All participants take the post-TABE test in week 21

GED TEST

In order to take the GED test a cadet must:

1. Be 17-18 years old or a Junior or Senior at school grade level school
2. Finish all packets in English and math with an 80% or better grade
3. Have signed approval of teaching staff and parents
4. Must have Oregon State ID card.

DIPLOMA

In order to earn a High School Diploma at OYCP a participant must have 24 credits, and meet Oregon State Graduation Requirements. The credits must be in the following:

1. ENGLISH	4 CREDITS
2. MATH (Algebra 1 or equivalent)	3 CREDITS
3. SCIENCE	3 CREDITS
4. SOCIAL STUDIES	3 CREDITS
5. HEALTH	1 CREDIT
6. PE	1 CREDIT
8. APPLIED ARTS/FOR LANG.	3 CREDIT
9. ELECTIVES	<u>6 CREDITS</u>
TOTAL	24 CREDITS

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

All final grades in all courses are given equal value in computing the GPA.

GRADING SYSTEM

A = 4 GRADE POINTS/94%-100%

B = 3 GRADE POINTS/88%-93%

C = 2 GRADE POINTS/80%-87%

Any participants receiving below 80% will be required to have a tutor until their grade is improved

EDUCATIONAL "CREDITS" POLICY

Youth Challenge is set up primarily for students to attain 8.0 Oregon certified credits for completed class work during the 22 week session. Any credits earned above 8.0 are unusual and will be assessed on a **case by case** basis. This will take into account the transcript review, the student's grade in school and the returning school. **Participants shall NOT be allowed to graduate "early" or as a higher school grade status from OHCS.**
