THE PROGRAM

The Central Oregon Youth Investment Foundation (COYIF) has established a scholarship program to assist graduates of the Oregon Youth Challenge Program (OYCP) who are continuing their education in college, vocational school programs, or career training. Scholarships are offered for study at an accredited institution of the student's choice.

This Post Residential scholarship program is administered by the COYIF. The purpose is to provide scholarships, training and workforce transition assistance to the graduates of OYCP.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants to this Scholarship Program must be:

- An OYCP graduate.
- Have a clear understanding of your educational goals and how you plan to achieve them.
- Attending/enrolled at an accredited college, university, technical, or trade school or apprenticeship program.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential.

SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of successful completion of the OYCP Residential Phase, attendance/enrollment at an accredited institution, commitment to the Post Residential Phase, and an essay about their educational goals and aspirations.

Selection of the recipient is made by the Scholarship Committee at OYCP.

Applicants will be notified by the end of May 2019. Not all who apply will be selected as recipients.

OBLIGATIONS

Scholarships awarded will be paid directly by COYIF to the recipient's school of choice upon confirmation of the student's enrollment into an accredited institution. Scholarship funds must be used within six months of receipt. A request for extension may be submitted to COYIF, Mr. Dennis Luke, using the below contact information.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Recipients are required to supply COYIF with complete transcripts when requested and to notify COYIF of any changes to address, school enrollment, or other relevant information.
